Scholarship Eligibility:

Graduate students demonstrating financial need who are pursuing MS or Ph.D. degrees in Aerospace, Civil, Computer, Electrical, Environmental, Engineering Management, Mechanical, or Systems Engineering may be eligible for a Marine Engineering Scholarship/Assistantship if their intended course of study and research pertains to Marine Engineering or Marine Engineering Technology.

Application Package Checklist:

- Completed and accurate Marine Engineering Scholarship/Assistantship Application,
- A short paragraph stating why you want to study marine engineering as it applies to your discipline,
- One letter of recommendation from a faculty member, and
- Unofficial copies of all post-secondary transcripts

NOTE: Applicant MUST have financial need of at least \$1000 per year, as determined by Federal Guidelines. This requires that ODU have on file a current copy of applicant's 2009-2010 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at the time the award offer is made. Visit www.fafsa.ed.gov to file your FAFSA. Scholarship award cannot exceed amount of financial need.
